CAMRA Pub of the Year 2022!

In April the Fox & Goose was presented with CAMRA Halifax and Calderdale's top award, Pub of the Year 2022, for the second time since becoming a community-owned co-operative pub.

Branch Chair Richard Lee commented on the pub's high quality customer service, knowledgeable staff, excellent ales and the range and diversity of beer styles. He also referred to the extensive refurbishment of the outdoor area and the range of musical and other events put on. In the past few months, we have also had beers supporting Ukraine and commemorating the great industrial strike of 1842, as well as adding to our range of alcoho free beers and cider. We would like to commend our wonderful staff for this achievement.

The Fox And Goose is a real community pub.

We serve real alse from microtrevens, real closers, craft lager on draught, a range of continental bottled lagers and beers plue craft beer i mans. We also serve callity winse, spirito, por kipe, vegan parales, quality tas, burists coffees and tempting fresh caus. At The Force and Goose we believe in fairness which is why we only serve draught beer in lined oversize glasses. That way when you orde part of beer you get a pint of liquid reteriment plus as gravement bead. Most direct public and plus areas a pint in a "brinding" glass as you cloring de at lup int of lower directment plus as comments when the direct direct public and plus marked and plus direct way produce subscripts to being at the centre of the community. The pub is owned by its users – over 300 of us. We are the first co-operative

with screen readers and magnifiers to ensure the website will be available to everyone, but if anyone has particular experience in this area then we'd like to hear your opinions.

Calder Grub Hub & Community Food

The Fox and Goose is getting involved with <u>Calder</u> <u>Grub Hub</u>, who will be supplying a free supper for anyone in need on Wednesday evenings 5-7pm at Hope Baptist Church. There is now a food donation box in the pub for anyone to drop off canned or dry goods to be donated to the project, with any surplus going to Calder food support.

The pub will also be arranging free coffee mornings on Sundays 11am-midday, where we will supply free tea, coffee or juice to anyone with a voucher supplied at the Grub Hub. The first one on Sunday 11th September will be supported by <u>Kitchen 91</u>, who will be donating some baked goods. If anyone wants to donate cake or biscuits for the Sunday coffee mornings that would be much appreciated.

We also receive bread and food donations from St

James Church on Sunday mornings which will be available for anyone to collect from the pub on Sundays.

We would like to thank those who volunteered to help clear the Himalayan balsam from the woodland alongside the pub recently, as well as those involved in our spring clean event earlier in the year.
